Gardet Brut NV £60.00  
*Fresh, full bodied Champagne with fine acidity and a solid creamy structure, with toasty hints and a long finish.  
Awarded Gold Medal at Decanter World Wine Awards*

### Sparkling Wine

Distilleria Bottega Vino Dei Poeti Prosecco Brut Sparkling, Italy £35.50  
*Fragrant, fresh, dry and well balanced, with delicate flowery fruits, and scents of golden apple*

Emilie Laurance Brut Rosé £31.50  
*Pale pink, Dominated by red berries with subtle vanilla notes and well-rounded with intense fruity flavours*

Emilie Laurance Brut Mousseux £28.50  
*Pale gold with fine bubbles, delicate floral aromas and a crisp clean finish*

### House White Selection

Casa Silva Family Chardonnay Semillion, Colchagua Valley, Chile, 2018 £23.00  
*A fresh crisp fruity wine with hints of tropical fruits, and well balanced elegant acidity*

IGP Honore de Berticot, Cote de Duras, Sauvignon Blanc, France, 2017 £23.00  
*An elegant Sauvignon Blanc with well balanced acidity with ripe fruit and hints of freshly mown hay*

Grenache Blanc La Loupe, France, 2018 £23.00  
*Fragrant with hedgerow flowers and orange blossom. A wine to be enjoyed young and fresh, with a mid-bodied palate rich with flavours of acacia, peach and greengages balanced by a dry mineral finish*

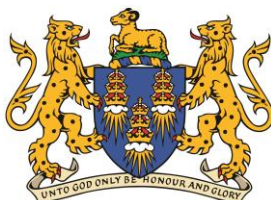
Lisboa Branco Chardonnay Casa do Lago, Portugal 2018 £23.00  
*Dry and medium bodied, perfectly ripe grapes have given this wine a pronounced fresh aroma on the nose of lemon, white flowers and a touch of honeysuckle. The palate has an excellent balance of mouth filling green apple and melon fruit with white blossom and greengages, and an unusual white pepper-like spiceiness*

### White Wines

Château La Tuilerie du Puy, Entre Deux Mers, France, 2017 £27.50  
*Yellow robe, with an aromatic nose of apricots and citrus fruits. Round and fruity with elegant acidity.*

Fiano Lunate IGT Sicilia, Italy, 2018 £28.50  
*Crisp and fresh with stone fruit flavours and is complimented by a refreshing acidity making this wine beautifully balanced.*

Chardonnay Sur Lie "Bon Vallon" Dewetshof, South Africa, 2017 £32.50  
*This Chardonnay is a fresh and expressive, unwooded version. The nose is delicate with aromas of lemon, honey blossom and peach. The wine was matured on its lees to produce a vibrant, lemony dry wine with a yeasty and delicate nutty finish.*

Casa Silva Family Cabernet Sauvignon Merlot, Colchagua Valley, Chile, 2018 <i>Ruby red in colour. Powerful notes of red plums, with round soft fruit and well-balanced tannins</i>	£23.00
Rioja Tunante Tempranillo Fincas de Azabache, Spain, 2018 <i>This plummy, soft seductive wine exhibits typical Tempranillo character of red fruits such as cherry, raspberry and plum with notes of liquorice and finishes soft and rounded</i>	£23.00
La Loupe Grenache Noir Rouge, France, 2017 <i>The nose is peppery with herbal scents and juicy ripe fruit flavours typical of the Languedoc, together with a smooth texture and supple, mouth filling finish</i>	£23.00
Lisboa Touriga Cabernet Casa do Lago, Portugal, 2017 <i>The deep ruby colour of this wine indicates its full bodied, fruity style offering aromas of blackcurrant, leather and spice. It has a delicious, rich, concentrated flavour of ripe berry fruits, yet is well structured and extremely smooth on the palate.</i>	£23.00

Château La Tuilerie du Puy, Bordeaux Superieur, France, 2015 <i>Deep dark red with an intense fruit nose of blackcurrant and blackberry. Ripe, rich and concentrated with good balance</i>	£27.50
Douro Valley Vega Tinto DFJ Vinhos, Portugal, 2016 <i>Rich and full bodied but very smooth in the mouth with plum, cherry and mineral elements and complex with a firm grip of tannins, typical of the region</i>	£28.50
Delheim Pinotage. Stellenbosch, South Africa, 2015 <i>Bright crimson and purple hues. Ripe plums, black cherry and raspberries on the nose, with concentrated rich fruit and well integrated oak.</i>	£32.50

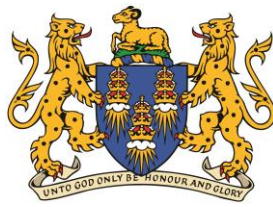
